


# DARUSSALAAM COLLEGE NEWS LETTER


#### **Essay Competition Results**

Mrs. F. Rahmy assisted in the much-needed repair of chairs, contributing to the upkeep of the school's infrastructure.




#### Sri Lanka Schools National Championship 2025 U-20 Division 1 Tournament
