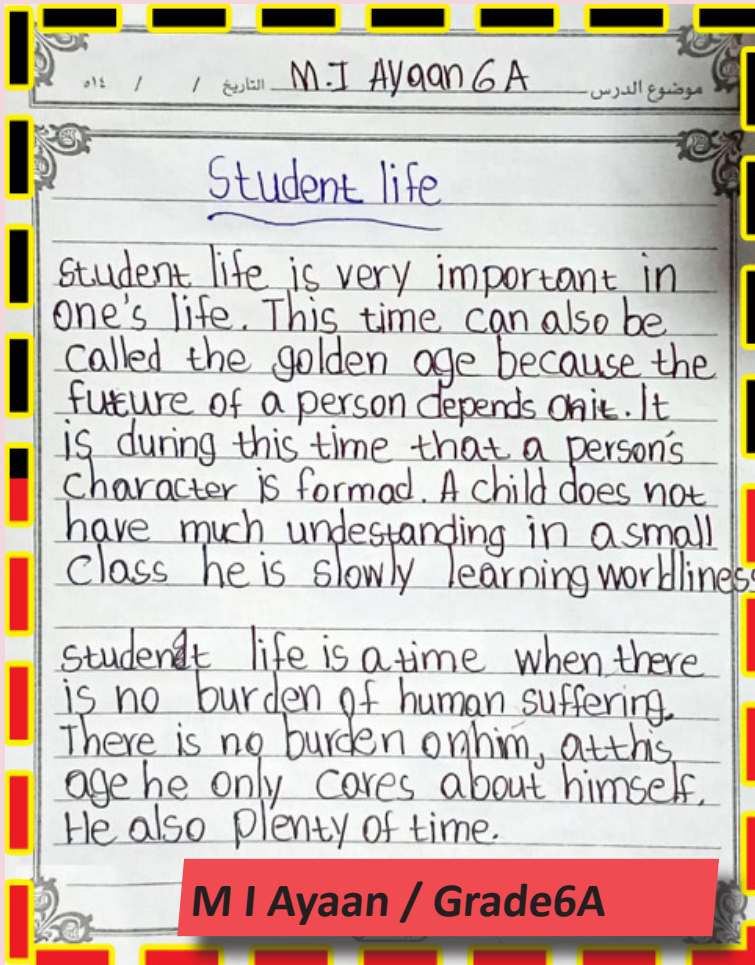

The Place Where Learning Begins

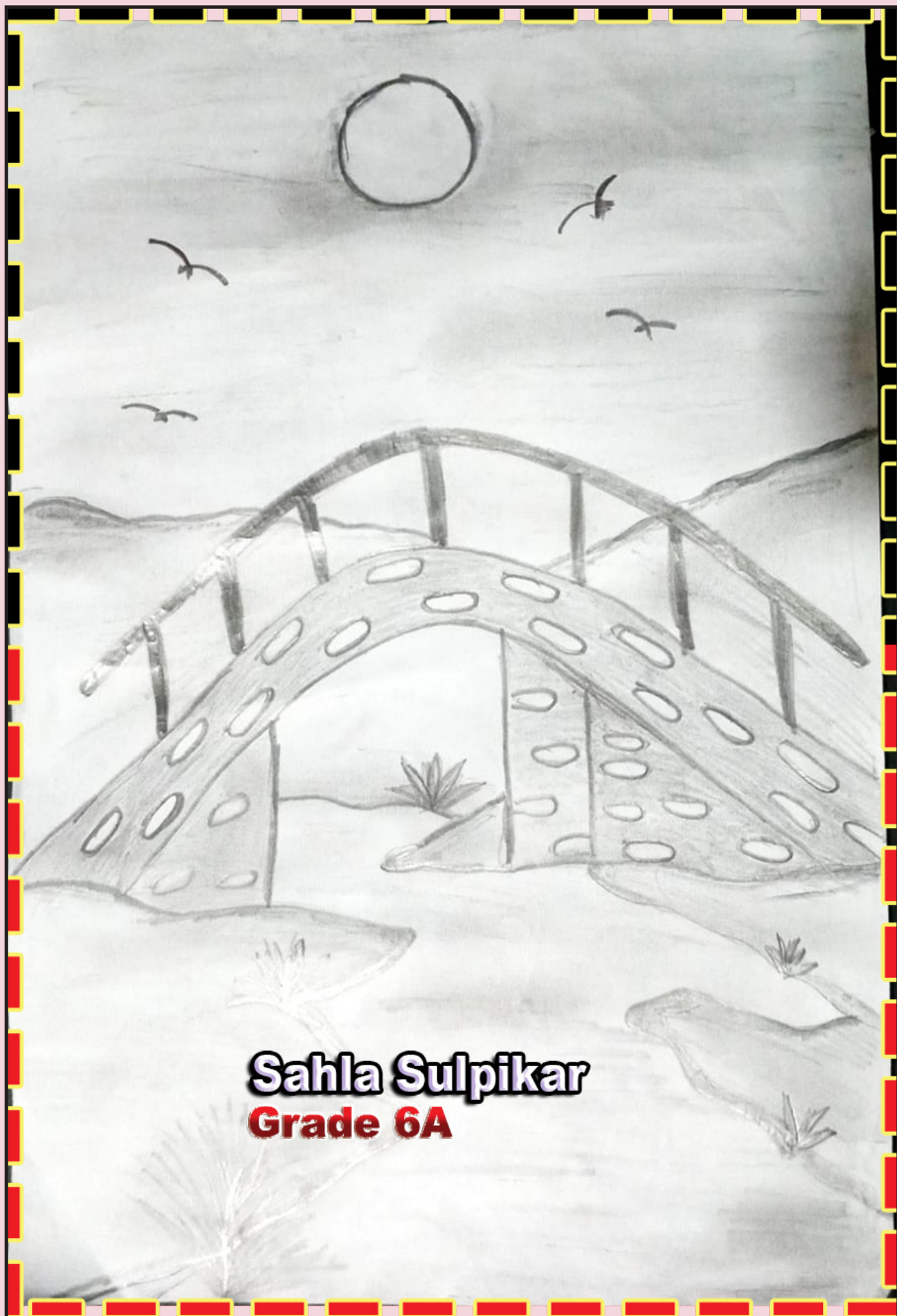

1-What are your tips to improve writing skills?

To improve writing skills, students should develop a daily reading habit, learn new vocabulary to use in their work, and always plan their essays with a clear structure—including an introduction, body, and conclusion.

2- What's the most common mistake you see students make in their writing, and how can I avoid it?

Many students do not follow the fundamental rules of writing. They often neglect grammar, language style, organization, and writing mechanics when completing a writing task. To avoid these problems, students must practice regularly. Before writing, they should understand the topic clearly and create a brief outline.

3-Besides the required reading, what books would you recommend for a student who wants to read more?

Reading novels and stories improve writing skills. There are simplified versions of novels. It's good to read them regularly.

4- How do you approach teaching a classic text versus a contemporary one?

When I teach a classic text, I explain the story's background, its historical period, and the author's life. I help students with new vocabulary and its meaning. Finally, we discuss the text's main ideas.

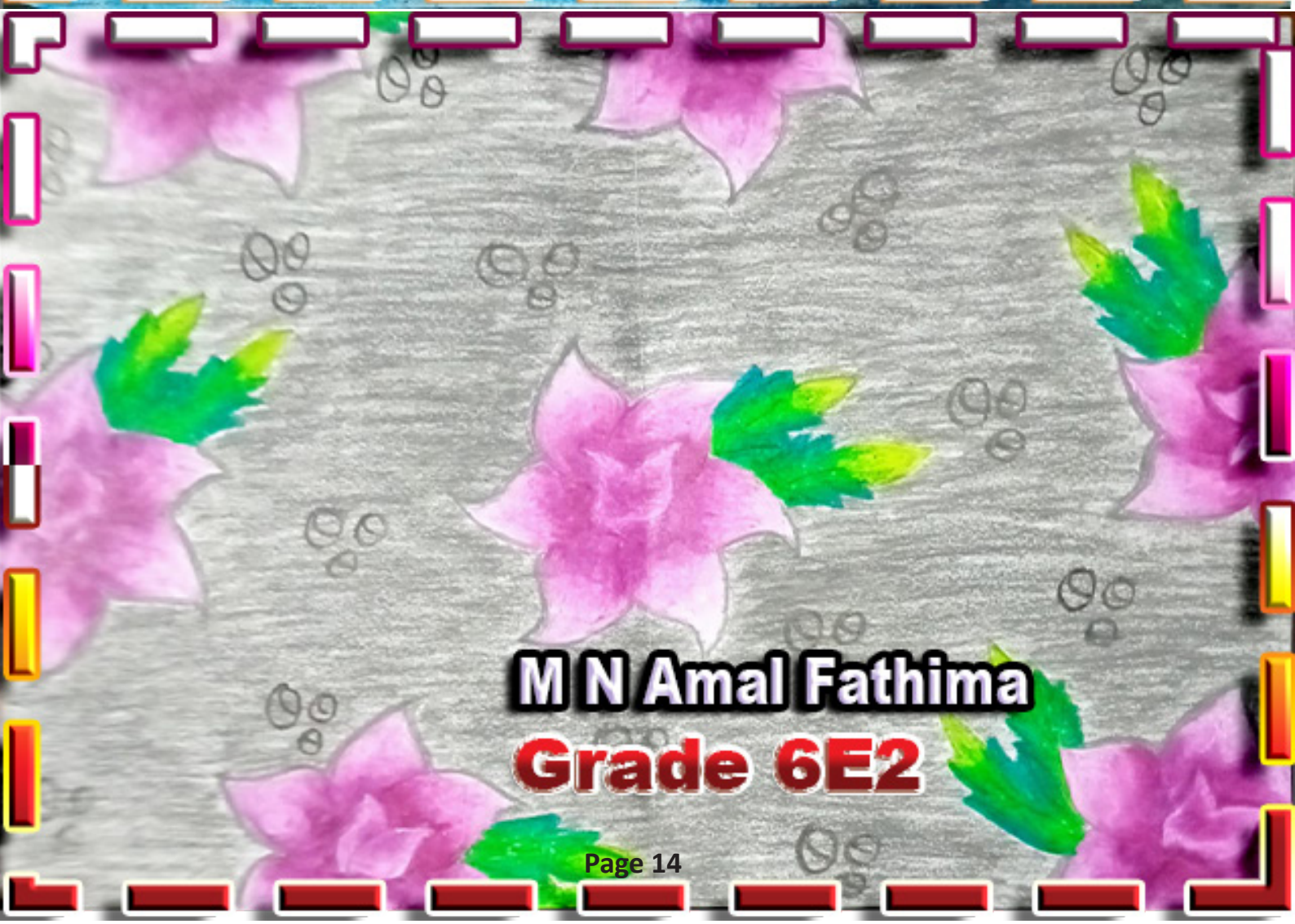
For a contemporary text I focus and compare with the life of today's society. We spend more time on talking about the characters, problems and the lessons we learn from them

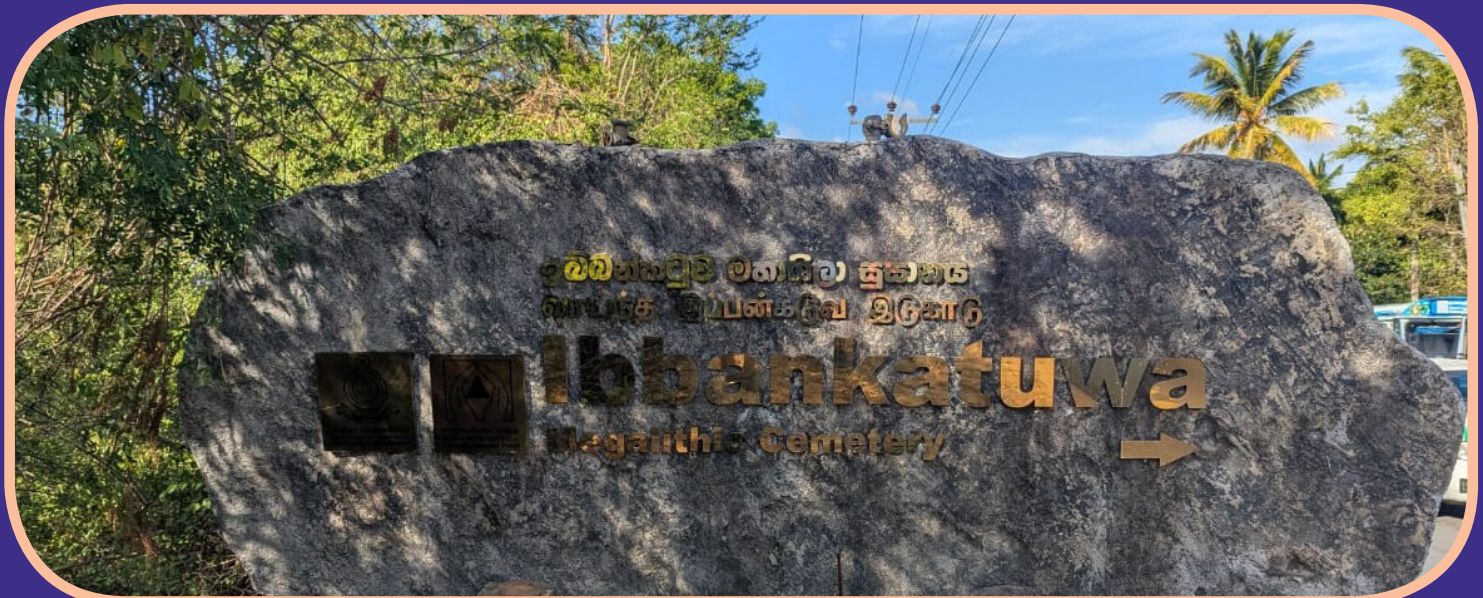
